# Crossroads of America

Within the United States, truck delivery is often more economical than ships or trains. Ranking number one in pass-through highways, Indiana is within a one-day drive of 80% of the U.S. population. The median center of U.S. population has fallen within Indiana since 1950.

- Four interstate highways intersect in central Indiana, making the Indianapolis Region the leading metro area in America with direct interstate access to other markets.
- Indiana has three state-of-the-art international ports – each a Foreign Trade Zone – located on two of America’s busiest inland waterways.
- The world’s second-largest FedEx facility is located at Indianapolis International Airport. The eighth-largest cargo airport in North America, Indianapolis International can accommodate all cargo aircraft.
- Indiana ranks fourth in the United States in rail carloads carried and seventh in volume of NAFTA exports, totaling \$15 billion per year.

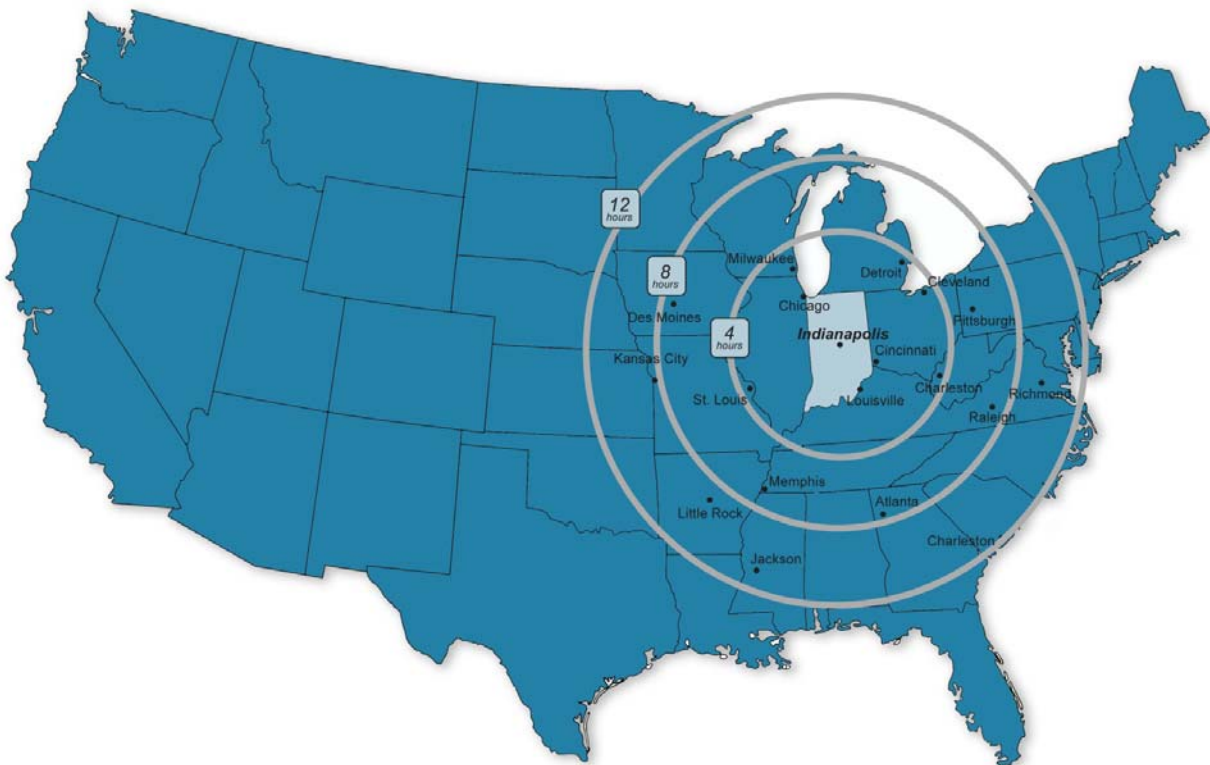
