12.4% of Marion County's population and 8.9% of the metro population speak a language other than English at home.

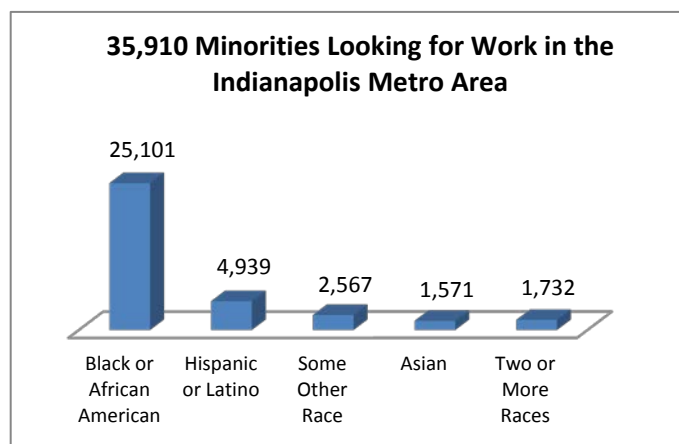
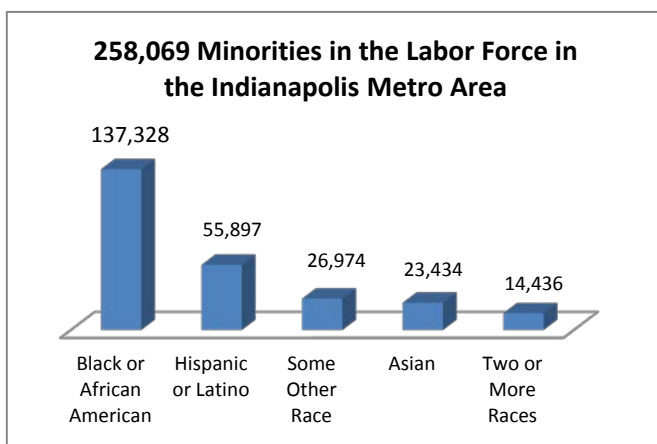
