

# Indianapolis International Airport

## Airport Facts & Statistics

Each year Indianapolis International Airport (IND) serves about 7.3 million passengers and handles over 1.1 million pounds of cargo. The new IND terminal was ranked #1 in passenger experience in 2010 by J.D. Power and Associates and the best airport in North America in 2010, 2012, 2013 and 2014 by Airports Council International. In 2014 Conde Naste *Traveler* readers rated it the Best Airport in America. IND is an important contributor to Central Indiana's economy, employing 10,000 people daily with an economic impact of \$4.5 billion.



## Daily Departures and Destinations

On average, there are 135 daily departures to 38 nonstop destinations from Indianapolis. Although a handful of flights are seasonal, service is generally available to locations listed below. Major carriers currently include Air Canada, AirTran, Allegiant, American, Delta, Frontier, Southwest, United and US Airways.
