The International School of Indiana (ISI) was the first school in Indiana to be authorized by the International Baccalaureate (IB) Organization to offer all three IB programs, and only the second school in the entire Midwest to achieve this distinction. ISI is the 14th school in the United States to be authorized for all three programs. An additional nine public high schools in the region offer an IB diploma.
